WASTE / COMPOSITING

Unfortunately, the land we bought for the Hop Inn dream will have to be sold. During the protracted planning process, we have been taking all the waste to our compost site on the land and prior to that we were using a friend's farm. In 2019 and going forward these options will no longer be available. We have looked at several options to dispose of the waste and left with the only option to have it taken away, but this will be an additional cost.

HAY

There are murmurs of a hay shortage this year as the majority of farmers were only able to cut one crop, due to the high temperatures and lack of rain, so trying to stay ahead of the game I have reserved quite a few bales of meadow hay - just in case there really is a shortage!

In the past, I have used a combination of seed hay and a little meadow hay, but due to the hot summer I found the seed hay a little too spikey – so always thinking of our furry friend's creature comforts I'm moving to just meadow hay in the future.
